### 2024 Candidate Endorsement Meeting

#### Voting for 2024 Endorsements

Please join us as we welcome candidates in the 2024 election cycle and make our endorsements!

On February 8, we heard from the Assembly candidates and asked questions. We did not, however, discuss the candidates or vote.

On February 22, we will hear from the candidates, or their representatives, running for State Committee in the 69th (2 seats), Countywide Civil Court (4 seats) and the 5th District Civil Court (1 seat), State Senate in the 30th, the House in the 12th and 13th, a U.S. Senate seat, and Judicial delegates and alternates for our part of the 69th (5 seats each). **On February 22**, we'll vote to endorse for all these offices, including Assembly.

- As with the meeting on February 8, this meeting is hybrid; you can attend in-person or by Zoom. If so, you will be able to participate by phone, even if you can't use the Zoom video features. Zoom attendees using video WILL be able to ask questions through the chat but won't be able to participate fully in the discussion.
- We will be voting at this meeting, again in a hybrid process we have never attempted before. Attendees in person will be voting on paper ballots which they can request at the meeting until 8:00pm. Zoom attendees will have to vote online; starting at 8:30pm, emails with personalized links will be emailed out. (Double-check your spam folder!)
- It appears that the **new lines** for the 12th and 13th Congressional Districts will be settled in time for the meeting, which means petitioning for all offices will take place as scheduled and all the candidates will be on the ballot for the primary on June 25th.

We look forward to seeing you on February 22!

#### **Eligibility to Vote in Club Elections**

To vote in club elections (endorsements, elections of officers, judicial convention delegates, amendments), you must be an eligible voting member of the Broadway Democrats:

- You must live in the 69th Assembly District, or an area that used to be in the 69th AD before redistricting;
- You can't have voted in any elections in any other club in this calendar year;
- You must have attended at least one of the previous nine monthly public meetings; and

You must be current with your dues. Dues are \$25 (\$10 for students and seniors) and may be paid by check mailed to Broadway Democrats, P.O. Box 1099, New York, NY 10025 or <u>Pay Your Dues Online</u>, using PayPal or a debit/credit card. When you pay your dues, please include your email address and telephone number.
