2024 Endorsements

Please join us as we welcome candidates in the 2024 election cycle and make our endorsements.

Candidates

We will be dividing the candidates into two forums. On February 8th, we will hear from the candidates running for Assembly in the 69th AD. On February 22nd, we will be voting for all candidates and hearing from the candidates/surrogates running for State Committee in the 69th, several Civil Court seats, State Senate in the 30th, the House in the 12th and 13th (maybe), one U.S. Senate seat, and Judicial delegates and alternates for our part of the 69th. (Let us know if you're interested in running. We prefer you run as an alternate if it's your first time.) We will vote on the 22nd so the February 8th meeting is your last chance to qualify to vote.

- Both meetings are in person, but we are going to try to go "hybrid" and have access by Zoom as well. If so, you will be able to participate by phone, even if you can't use the Zoom video features. Participation through Zoom will be limited for the time being.
- We don't know when the Primary for the House of Representatives will be. New York is going through yet another round of redistricting over those lines, as the result of a lawsuit. We hope this will be done in time for the June Primary, but it is possible that we will have a second Primary in August.
- We look forward to seeing you on February 8th and 22nd!

Eligibility to Vote in Club Elections

To vote in club elections (endorsements, elections of officers, judicial convention delegates, amendments), you must be an eligible voting member of the Broadway Democrats:

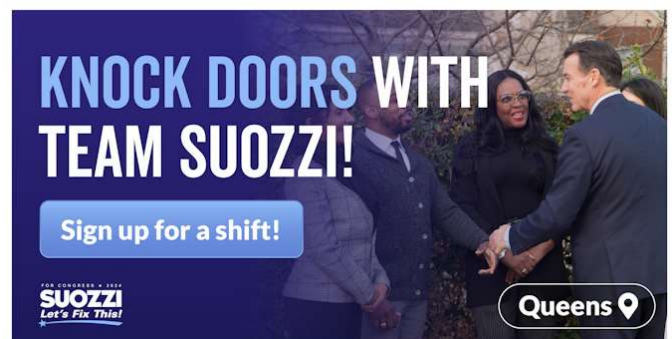
- You must live in the 69th Assembly District, or an area that used to be in the 69th AD before redistricting;

- You can't have voted in any elections in any other club in this calendar year;
 - You must have attended at least one of the previous nine monthly public meetings; and
- You must be current with your dues. Dues are \$25 (\$10 for students and seniors) and may be paid by check mailed to Broadway Democrats, P.O. Box 1099, New York, NY 10025 or [Pay Your Dues Online](#), using PayPal or a debit/credit card. When you pay your dues, please include your email address and telephone number.
